Executive summary

The website is designed to be a practical framework for CYRUS communications activities, and it will be updated during the project.

1 Introduction

The website provides information on the project itself, its main objective, the activities, the consortium, and the references to the website of each partner and it will be considered the heart of the dissemination activity.

The project website will be updated throughout the project duration with public information about the activities' status, progress, news and any other relevant information. The dissemination goal will be to:

- Spread relevant information about the project (such as agenda of events and research papers);
- Inform the transport and manufacturing community, and the stakeholders about the project activities and goals;
- Promote the use of project results and provide access to the set of cybersecurity training courses that will be produced within the project (knowledge center page).

As stated in the DoA [1], Deep Blue is responsible for the design, realisation, and maintenance of the website. At the same time, EITM as leader of the communication and dissemination activities, will be responsible for updating the website. The other partners will contribute by providing information, documents, news, or any other material that they consider helpful to disseminate the progress of the project.

1.2 Website architecture

The website is based on a modular CMS (wordpress) that allows the addition of plug-ins with interactive features to be used for engaging the general audience in the project activities. A template has been customised to the needs of the project architecture and functionalities.

All the sections contain images and highlight boxes to create easy to read pages.

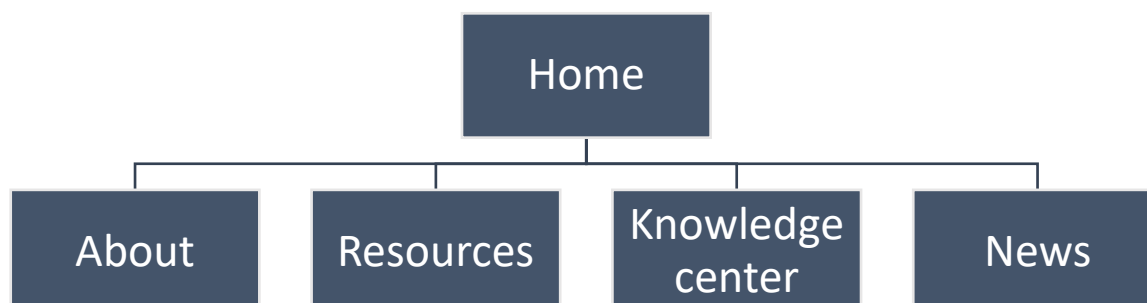


Figure 1: Website architecture

The architecture allows the integration of new pages and sections during the project to satisfy evolving communication and dissemination needs and keep the project agile.

As mentioned in D4.1 [1], the website is composed of the following pages:

- Home page: an introductory, scroll-down page with general information about the project.
- About: this page describes the methodological approach, the conceptual framework, and the project consortium.
- Resources: this section includes the downloadable resources of the project, comprising communication and graphic materials (flyers, brochures, posters), deliverables, videos, reports, and papers.
- Knowledge Center: The Knowledge Center will be a dedicated page of the project website. It will be established to collect all project outputs and present competence framework and curricula, training modules, activities, and guidelines. The Knowledge Center will also be linked to the Digital Skills and Jobs Platform, where the CYRUS short-term training course package will be promoted, and the training modules will also be listed.
- News: this section will be constantly updated with all the latest news about the project and the events in which the members of the CYRUS project will be involved.

The page's layout is composed of three main sections:

- Header, which includes the project logo and the main menu.
- Content area, which varies from page to page.
- Footer with project contacts and EU disclaimer.
