Free cybersecurity training courses

As technology becomes more central to our daily lives, the need for strong cybersecurity is growing. Every employee, regardless of their role, should be aware and able to identify cyber threats and know how to respond.

CYRUS is a collaborative project with eleven partners working together to create practical cybersecurity training courses. These courses are designed to reskill and upskill professionals in the transport and manufacturing sectors. We focus on non-technical staff, including management, HR and finance,

as well as engineers and operators. And the best part? The courses are for free!

In the first year of the project, we listened to the industry. Through surveys, interviews and workshops, we identified the real challenges companies face. Based on this, we developed and tested the training courses with over 500 participants between July and October 2024. Their feedback helped us improve the courses to ensure they are both practical and relevant.

What is in it for you?

- **Flexible e-learning:** take the courses anytime, anywhere
- **Multiple languages:** available in English, Polish, Italian and German with more languages to come
- **Three skill levels:** beginner, skilled and expert
- **Short and focused:** each training takes a maximum of four hours
- **Certificates included:** plus a “Certificate of excellence” for high test scores
- **Real-world case studies and interactive content:** for practical and relevant training

Who are the training courses for?

- **Administrative staff:** Non-technical roles such as managers, HR and finance with no direct access to the technical infrastructure or the operation of the system
- **Operators:** Non-technical roles with access to the technical infrastructure through severely constrained human-machine interfaces (HMI). Operate the systems but typically cannot change it
- **Engineers:** Technical roles with direct access, possibly without constraints from an HMI, who can modify the technical infrastructure
